That in conformity with a Survey made on the ninth day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty four by virtue of Land Office Treasury Warrant, No. 18580

there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto Abram Reedy,

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing Seventy one acres, lying in Grayson County, on waters of Jones branch, a branch of Little Helton creek and bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at a white oak and spanish oak sapling on the side of a hill at or near a line of the lands of Timothy Young, dec'd and is allotted to Eli S. Young an heir of said Timothy Young: S. 80. E. 60 poles to two chestnut oaks, corner to the land of the said Reedy, with a line of the same, with 40 poles to a Chestnut N. 32. E. 164 poles, crossing several hollows, to two chestnuts by a fence, leaving Reedy's lines N. 40. W. 70 poles to a Chestnut on a ridge thence down said ridge: S. 75. W. 34 poles to a locust in a flat in a line of the lands of John Henderson with the same S. 13. E. 59 poles to two chestnuts on a steep hill side. S. 28. W. 96 poles to a white oak and two lymns near a hollow. Thence leaving Henderson's lines W. 24. N. 92 poles to the beginning with its appurtenances
